Front Royal 2382 used the \$2,000 Beacon Grant from the Elks National Foundation to deliver food to 20 families in the community. The Front Royal Police Dept provided the names of deserving families and helped deliver to the last five families who were in secure buildings.

In March, the Elks used a \$2,000 Freedom Grant provided by the Elks National Veterans Service Commission to purchase a kiln for the hobby shop at the Martinsburg (West Virginia) VA Hospital. The kiln, which cost \$2,768, replaced a broken one used for therapy for the veterans.
