1 - Check for \$1,000 to Arthur (Bunky) Woods, IV, local Wounded Warrior. The money was raised at the Car Show held by the lodge on September 6th. Bunky served two tours in Iraq and was wounded so badly during the second tour that he was paralyzed. He also decided during his visit to our lodge that he wants to be an Elk.

2 - Check for \$1,000 to Jeremy Cook, Pantry Administrator for Loaves & Fishes, a local Food Bank. The money was part of the profits raised at the Cash Party held by our PERs on September 13th at the lodge.

3 - Also, a Certificate from Elks National Foundation was awarded to Elk Virginia Feehan for her donations to ENF of over \$1,000.

Our ENF Breakfasts are held on the first Sunday of each month. The lodge pays for the food. Volunteers cook and serve the food (and clean up the kitchen) and the entire free-will donations go to the Elks National Foundation. On this day, the volunteers were Candy Laraby, Rick Morder, Dennis and Linda Henline & Bob & Susan Conway. They raised a record \$1,000 for their efforts, thanks to Candy's Pumpkin Pancakes, Rick's Cheesy Scrambled Eggs and Dennis' sausage gravy, and much, much more food.
