## Front Royal 2382 Uses ENF Grant to Fund Area Youth Needs

On Friday, October 31st, ER Dennis Henline and Jane Wine, Lodge Secretary, visited Rappahannock High School where the ER presented 100 Elks Safety Glasses to the Technology & Engineering Teacher, Scott Schlosser. They then traveled to Fauquier County School Board Office and met Pam Pulver, Science



Supervisor, who accepted 1,000 Elks Safety Glasses for their four high schools. Ms. Pulver and Sarah Frye, Supervisor for Career Technology Education, will distribute the glasses to the chemistry and science labs in the county. Front Royal Lodge decided to cover some of the areas that had once been covered by Warrenton/Culpeper Lodge this year, since they had already delivered 1,100 glasses to Warren and Shenandoah Co. schools last year.

On Wednesday, November 5th, ER Henline visited Samuels Public Library in Front Royal, where he presented a check for \$1,000 to Michal Ashby, Youth Services Supervisor for the Children's section. Ms. Ashby said the money would be used to purchase children's picture



books & help fund some small parties for the children. She said that is much needed, since the attendance has been growing for the younger children. Dennis Henline read a story to approximately 30 toddlers and 20 parents while he was there.
