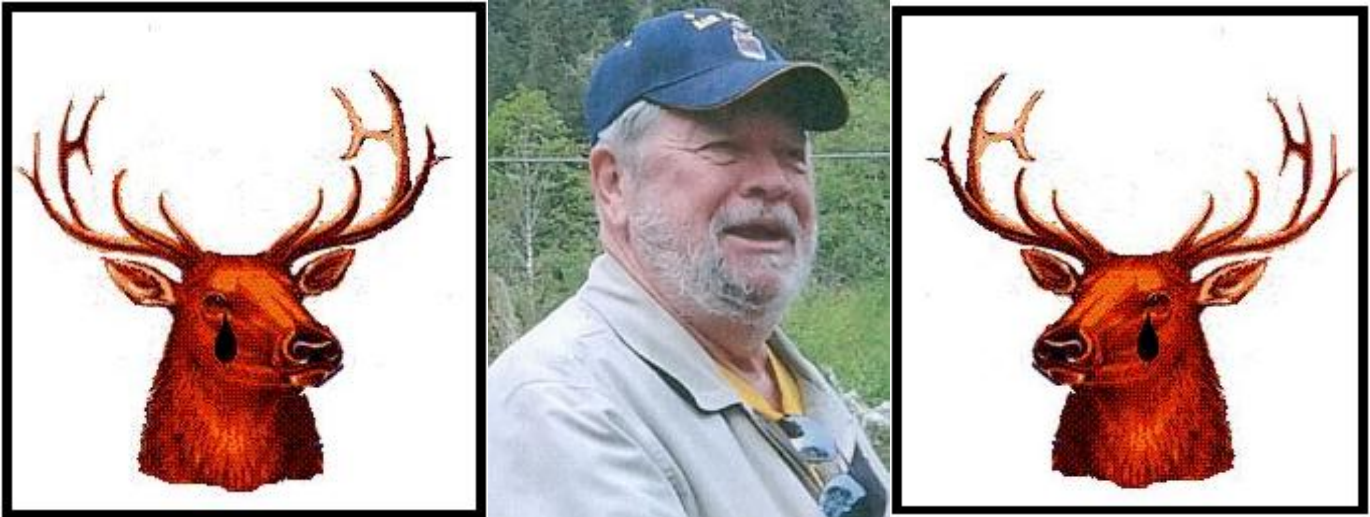

Obituary Details for Charles Edward (Chuck) Jordan Jr.



Charles Edward (Chuck) Jordan Jr., of Roanoke, died suddenly Thursday, December 25, 2014, at the age of 71. He was preceded in death by his mother, Elizabeth McPherson Jordan. He is survived by his wife, Christine Davis Jordan; father, Charles Jordan Sr., of St. Albans, W.Va.; daughter, Maria Carter of Winchester; son, Kirk Jordan (Jody) of Capon Bridge, W.Va.; and grandson, Ryan Carter, of Cincinnati, Ohio. Also surviving are sisters, Sandy Hughes (Tom), of Huntington, W.Va.; Karen Woodrum (Larry), of Winfield, W.Va.; Sandy Elimelack (Bob), of Boston, Mass.; and several nieces, nephews and one great niece.

Chuck was born April 4, 1943, in Charleston, W.Va. He served in the Air Force from 1961 to 1965. After careers in banking and at the Post Office, he retired to a life of traveling with his wife, painting, playing bridge, acting with local theater groups, and rooting for his favorite football teams (Go Steelers! Go Mountaineers!).

He was an avid volunteer, serving as the Veterans Coordinator for the local Roanoke Elks Lodge and was the Elks Veterans Volunteer Services Representative for Southwest Virginia. Chuck also volunteered at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital and was president of the local Mended Hearts Chapter. He was a member of the Cave Spring Lions Club and the Unitarian Universalist Church of Roanoke.

There will be a memorial service 2 p.m. Tuesday, December 30, 2014, at the Unitarian Church. A scattering of ashes will be at the family home place cemetery in West Virginia at a later date.
