## Petersburg 237 Distributes ENF MVS Info to Area High Schools



### MOST VALUABLE STUDENT COMPETITION

Petersburg 237 visited with seven area High Schools to promote the Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student Scholarships (MVS) awards. After discussing the on-line application with each school career counselor, posters were placed on each school's bulletin board emphasizing BPO Elks' Dedication to "HELPING STUDENTS GET A COLLEGE EDUCATION." Flyers will be given to students when requested.

The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2015 competition.

- Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.
- College students are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are signed; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.
- Male and female students compete separately.

2015 Most Valuable Student applications are due to the Elks Lodge closest to the applicant's home by December 5, 2014. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need.
