Note from John Cannon:

"I have just received a call from Mike Journell about Yvonne. On Saturday she was involved in a car accident on Rte. 321, Blount County, near Friendsville TN. Yvonne is hospitalized at the Knoxville University of Tennessee Medical Center. She has both legs broken, right ankle broken, broken ribs, broken wrist, and multiple other injuries and listed as critical. She will be undergoing surgeries for the conditions. Her daughter has multiple facial cuts and bruising and a concussion. Her daughter was in a coma for a period of time but has come out of it. A teammate of her daughter was in the car but no info was mentioned about her. They were on a basketball trip for a tournament.

"The woman who apparently pulled out in front of her car was pronounced dead at the scene.

"When Yvonne and her daughter improve they will probably be transferred to Roanoke for recovery and rehab.

"I'll pass along other info when I hear it."

Yvonne has several fractures. At this time, she had had two surgeries and will require several more. Daughter Bailey had several facial injuries that she had surgery on as well. Bailey's friend had some head trauma. Bailey was released yesterday, but Yvonne is still at the University of Tennessee at Knoxville.
